Overview

Tickets can be added to the system by manually entering, downloading from a scale house, downloading from an external file, or downloading from a hand held data collector.

The system provides for the following types of tickets:

Regular
Adjustment
Historical

Features

- Easy and flexible single-screen ticket entry
- Unlimited number of products per ticket
- Ticket volume is captured in three defined units of measure plus the actual volume in which the ticket is entered
- "Smart" ticket entry feature
- Extensive editing and error trapping
- Duplicate payment of a ticket is not allowed
- Optional fifteen-character reference field
- Optional thirty-character comments field
- Optional truck/driver prompting during ticket entry
- Easy and fast ticket search
- Multiple producers and owners per ticket
- Multiple methods of payment (units of measure) on each ticket (Example: Producer can be paid by the cord, hauler by the mile, and stumpage owner by the ton, etc.)
- Overweight deduction automatically calculated based on gross maximum weight
- Enter maximum amount in pounds or tons
- Ticket volume can be entered by: unit of measure, gross/tare units, or net pounds
- Conversion factor override during ticket entry
- Each ticket is tracked by load and post date
- The total destination income, production cost, trucking cost, stumpage/inventory cost, and the gross profit is displayed on each ticket
- Ticket entry rates are controlled by job codes
- Credit ticket processing
- System provides complete audit trail for edited or credited tickets
- Enter positive or negative adjustment tickets with volume and amounts, volume only, or amounts only
- Culls can be setup as products, or as an attachment to the product

When the "Cycle" flag is checked, the system retains most of the ticket header information from the previously entered ticket.

The total dollar amount (if applicable) for the destination, owner, hauler, and producer are shown in "cyan" at bottom of the window.

The total gross profit amount is shown in "yellow" if a profit, and in "red" if a loss.

The total dollar amount (if applicable) for a mill advance, severance tax, and accounts receivable are shown in "cyan" in the upper right corner of the window.

The top half of the window represents the ticket header information.

The bottom half represents the ticket detail information. The ticket detail defaults to displaying the "Volume Entry" information. To display the "Stick Scale" information click on the Stick Scale tab.

To display the "Truck/Driver Information", click on the Truck/Driver Tab.

To override the default pounds per unit as defined in the tract file, click the Detail button. The "Detail" button also displays other detail information regarding the ticket.
